The architectural studio's passion for designing objects paved the way for its participation in the exhibition "when architecture enlightens us" at the Wallonie-Bruxelles Centre in Paris in 2006, the design biennials of Liège in 2004 and 2006 and in the MOBILIER#3 at the contemporary art center /2003.

Since 1998, the studio is regularly entrusted with scenography commissions, both in Belgium and abroad. These commissions have sometimes resulted in the study of exhibition furniture and lighting equipment.


