## About

Located in a forest, this architecture dialogue with its environment.

The new construction, access and edge are the result of physical constraints of the site. From the outset, our primary objective was to respond to the wishes and needs of our customers while wishing to retain the spirit of place.

In addition to this landscape character gave up young trees, the presence of a pond (existing) in turn influences the location of the building, both in its decline in its longitudinal direction. This is dictated by the location, to minimize interaction with the neighborhood while incorporating the most construction in the community.

This single-family dwelling stands on three levels with only the ground floor and upstairs emerge from the earth. She wears a double-slope roof covered with slate. For the sake of continuity, this material, extending the walls of the floor, features a simple and pure volume in contrast to a base to the more brutal (bluestone brick).

The two volumes are shifted smoothly to give the house a momentum and a lightness while accentuating the longitudinal dynamics of the site.

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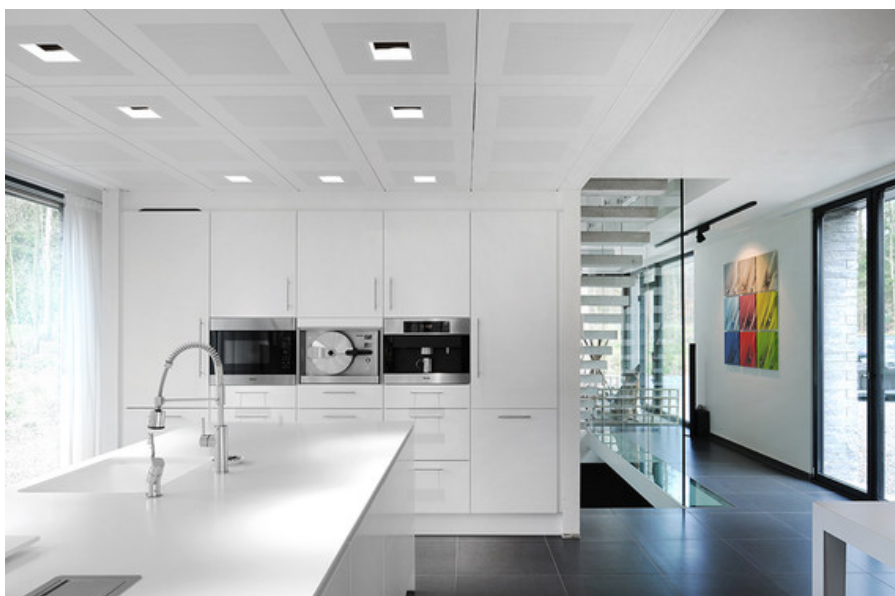
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
