## Programme

Large scale conversion of a compartmentalised and dark cellar of a single family home into a beauty parlor open to the garden.

## About

To carry out our project we had to modify the support structure of the house and reorganise the space.

We centred our project on the oblique line between the front facade and the rear facade in order to create crossing path. This organisation leads the clients to the heart of the institute: the main care room flooded with natural light.

All the rooms are designed as white boxes (walls, floor and ceiling) and are connected to each other by the oblique line covered with birch multiplex.

We used multiplex as a contemporary reinterpretation of old mouldings. For the shelves, the counter, the coving and the bench we used birch multiplex panels composed of several layers. This material gives the impression that these elements stand out. The walls are covered with multiplex and thus appear as massive elements.

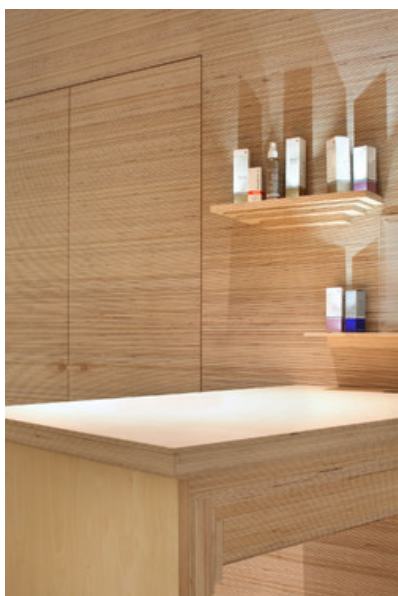
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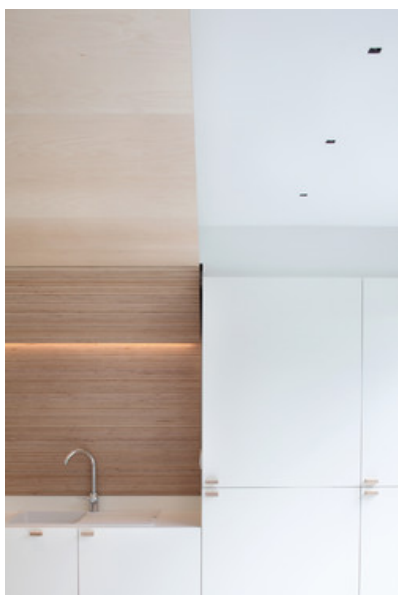
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
