## EDOUARD CABAY WITH IAAC: EXHIBITION AUTO-MÀTIC -BARCELONA

From June 29thtill September 2nd auto-màtic exhibition, hosted at the Centre d'Art Santa Mònica, a formerRenaissance convent in the heart of Barcelona's La Rambla, converted into acontemporary art centre, addresses thelimits and potential of generative drawing, by exploring how the AutomationRevolution is shaping the work of architects, designers and creatives.

The research was developed within the framework of Machinic Protocols, a project directed by the Belgianarchitect Edouard Cabay, within IAAC's Master's in Advanced Architecture: "the title ?auto-màtic?'?, the curator explains ??isan homage to Jean Tinguely's Méta-matics, the series of machines that produceartwork and that investigate the forceful intrusion of technology in oursociety".

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Edouard Cabay hasbeen developing, since 2015, an investigation called Machinic Protocols whichuses automated drawing techniques in order to explore notions of indeterminacyand chance in space. The research has been carried mainly in the domain ofarchitectural academia yet strongly engages with other fields such ascomputational design, digital technologies, drawing as a representative mean, calligraphy and cartography.

He is an architect and professor ofarchitecture. He founded and currently directs Appareil, an experimentalarchitectural office in Barcelona. He teaches, as senior faculty, at theInstitute for Advanced Architecture of Catalonia where he also co-directs theOpen Thesis Fabrication program. He has taught experimental design studios at the Architectural Association School of Architecture in London, at the Ecole Specialed'Architecture in Paris and at the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne.

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
