
PIERRE HEBBELINCK SHORTLISTED FOR THE EU MIES AWARD 2019

383 works from 238 cities in 38 countries have been nominated for the 2019 European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture ? Mies van der Rohe Award.

The jury formed by Dorte Mandrup (Chairwoman), Frank McDonald, María Langarita, Kamiel Klaasse, ?tefan Ghenciulescu, Angelika Fitz and George Arbid has shortlisted 40 projects. Among them the Halles Perret in Montataire (France) designed by the Atelier d'Architecture Pierre Hebbelinck in collaboration with HBAAT.

The project consists in the transformation, renovation and extension of the Halles des Perret for a cultural centre housing a music school, dance school, broadcasting room and recording studio.
